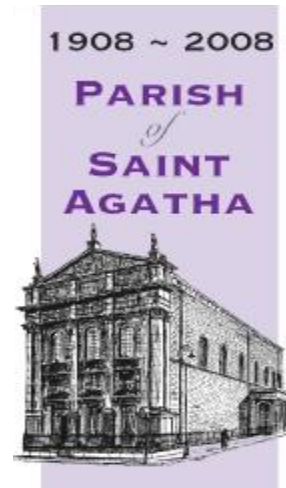


Centenary Light of Faith
