SEED COMPARED TO FAITH & HEAVEN

The mustard seed is small in size but it holds an explosive force; although it is sown in a small opening in the ground, it produces a huge living tree (shrub), with great outstretched branches where birds can nest and creatures find shelter from the scorching sun and rain. It benefits the earth and all who encounter it, because it responds to the gifts God sends it: rain and sunshine.



TH IS LIKE A SEED

In the same way faith produces great effects in the soul instantaneously. Like a seed our Faith was first planted in our souls in Baptism. Enlightened by faith, the soul pictures God and His Kingdom and sees Him clearly; enabling us also to respond to God's Gifts– His Grace and Teachings, which enabling our growth in spirit.

FAITH IN ACTION

Like the shrub, faith too, helps us to contribute positively to those in need, such as providing shelter, charity, love, alms and forgiveness. We must forgive each other if we are to find forgiveness from Christ Our King. We are called to listen and comfort the restless soul who God sends our way. Grace is the spiritual sunshine of the soul.

KINGDOM OF LOVE & MERCY

The Kingdom of God is not a geographical country. The Kingdom has no borders or boundaries. It is a State of Grace, Love and Forgiveness (Mercy), and begins here on earth. To practice these virtues is to allow the Kingdom within us to grow. Wherever Jesus is present, there is the Kingdom of Heaven which begins like a tiny seed in our soul

KING (CHRIST) DOM (THE LORD)

If we look at the word Kingdom, we see it is made up of two parts; King & Dom. *King* means *Christ* as He is our *King*. And *Dom* is the Latin word meaning, *the Lord*. So when I pray the *Our Father* and say; *Thy King-dom come*, I am inviting; *You, my Lord and King, to come to me and Reign my life*. Grow like the mustard seed making my home (body) with the Lord, as St Paul says in the second reading.

PATIENCE & TRUST

The patience and trust of the farmer who waits from seedtime to harvest is an image presented to us as a parable of growth reminding us that God's power is at work in us, night and day, and will generate the development and awareness of the Kingdom of Heaven or the Kingdom of God through our prayer, patience, obedience and trust in Him. We have to collaborate with His Grace (sunshine & rain) if we are to grow in spirit. The main ingredient of faith is Trust (in Jesus). Fr Brendan
