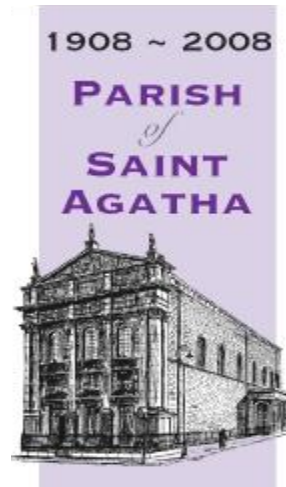
**Matt Talbot Sunday

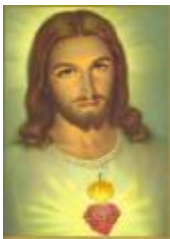
## Welcome to the new Church of Ireland Rector

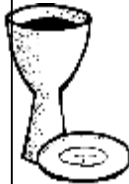
