Bridie Sharkey was born on 23rd November 1910 and at 100 years of age it's still no problem for her to hop on a bus and go into town.

She was born when her family were living on Portland Row, she has always been very active in St Agatha's Parish, so much so that well into her nineties she was still collecting the family offering envelopes and distributing St. Anthony's Messenger.

She remembers the First World War, the 1916 rising, the War of Independence and the Black and Tans. She recalls a young woman being shot on Ballybough Bridge because they thought she was an informer. She also told us she was once asked by the sacristan if she could come to the church, when she arrived there was a couple getting married who had no witnesses and so she became their bridesmaid.!

She told us her family had a piano and their house was always filled with music. Bridie speaks lovingly of her late twin sister Margaret, who passed away in April 2009 Bridie says "It's as if she's still with me to celebrate our Birthday."

Bridie is a life long member of the Legion of Mary and supporter of the Blessed Sacrament Fathers, she was very involved in helping with their move from D'Olier Street to Bachelors Walk.

When asked: What's the secret to living a long life, she said "Good plain food and home made scones and bread."
