A parishioner in thanksgiving for a favour to God, has donated a shrine for the Sacred Heart altar and two candlestick holders for the altar. Nearly a hundred years old the candlestick holders are very much in keeping with the church.

Since Monday's meeting of parishioners most of the refurbishment of the brasswork has been sponsored - the high candlesticks on the altar, the thurible, the processional cross, the sanctuary lamps, the baptismal font cover... At present all the brasswork is out being refurbished.
