Work on Church - Update

Church Organ Restoration

The restoration of the church pipe organ by Trevor Crowe Organ Builders is now complete and was passed by Professor Gerard Gillen the adviser to the project on Friday 21st February 2003.

The grant of €14,400 from the Dublin Docklands Development Authority was presented by Mr Matt Bolton.

A celebration evening is being planned to which all will be invited.

Work on the exterior of the church

- **New Lightning Protection System** has been installed on the church roof during the past week.
- Work on the re-pointing and cleaning of the exterior walls of the church is due to be finished during the next few weeks.
- Work on the repainting of the church railings and the repair of the hazardous trip areas of the church grounds is at present ongoing.

Church Heating improvements

Six new quartz heaters have been added to the present system - four at the back of the church and two in the gallery. In the coming weeks ten modern storage heaters will be installed into the church.

Church lighting

A complete set of new light bulbs was installed into the church during the past week. These bulbs have a limited lifespan of three to four years. Three bulbs went within one week so they all needed to be replaced.

Improved lighting for the gallery and choir will be installed during the coming week.

Cardinal Connell is asking the people of the Dublin Diocese to offer "fervent prayers for the situation involving Iraq and the Middle East, that world leaders and those with influence may do all that they can to work for the avoidance of war."
