Bethany Bereavement Support Group**

The Bethany Bereavement Support Group is a voluntary parish-based ministry, which aims to help the bereaved and grieving. The name *Bethany* recalls the visit of Jesus to Mary and Martha on the death of their brother, Lazarus.

Although grieving is a natural process which can be helped by sympathy and understanding of friends, sometimes one may need support to work through it in a positive way. Many Bethany members have themselves been bereaved. They are trained to listen with understanding. It helps the healing process to talk with a trained listener and confront the very strong feelings associated with grief.

Members of the Bethany Bereavement Support Group are available in the Prayer Room in St. Agatha's on the third Monday of the month.
