The Dublin Diocese is bringing approx 180 Sick Pilgrims to Lourdes from 7th to 12th September.

The Sick Pilgrims will be staying in the Accueil, which is close to the Grotto. They are cared for by voluntary doctors, nurses and helpers from all over Dublin. There are some helpers traveling from the Parish of St. Agatha to care for the Sick Pilgrims.

If some pilgrims are unable to afford some or most of he fare they are paid for by the *Lourdes Invalid Fund*. All applications are subject to consideration by the Pilgrimage Medical Board.

There is also a group of pilgrims from the Parish of St. Agatha travelling to Lourdes with the Dublin Diocesan Pilgrimage from 7^{th} to 12^{th} September. The group will be traveling with Joe Walsh Tours and staying at the Agena Hotel. The cost is **€685 per person** (*based on sharing*). Deposit of €100 is required to secure booking. The group leader is Sr. Bridget O'Connor.
