ALTAR LIST OF THE DEAD

You are invited to place the names of all those of your family and friends who have died on to the *Altar List of the Dead*. All those whose names that are entered on the *Altar List of the Dead* will be prayed for at all the Masses during the month of November. They are then kept at the back of the altar where they are included in the prayer of the Masses in our church until November 2003 when they will be shredded.

Altar List of the Dead envelopes can be obtained from the box at the altar rails.

When completed they can be:-

- Placed in the black box at the altar rails
- Put on the collection plate during Mass
- Or handed into the sacristy.
