As you are aware the continued provision and expansion of hospice services is vital. It is so important that we continue to strive together to ensure that the hospice is there for members of our community

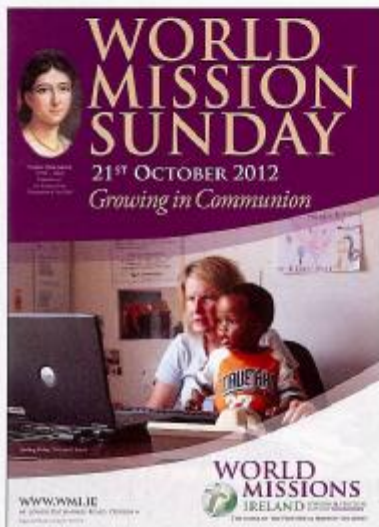
